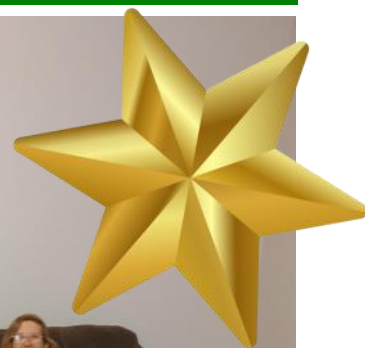

IMPORTANT INFO ABOUT WINTER TIRES !!!!!

1. WINTER TIRES ARE SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED FOR WINTER DRIVING CONDITIONS. THIS IS ESPECIALLY TRUE IN EXTREME COLD – IE – ICE.
2. WINTER TIRES ARE EQUIPPED WITH A SPECIAL SINGLE-DIRECTIONAL TREAD THAT PUSHES AWAY SNOW AND ICE.
3. MAKE SURE TO CHECK YOUR TIRES PRESSURE REGULARLY. AS THE TEMPERATURES DROP, THE PRESSURE IN YOUR TIRES WILL DECREASE.
4. WHEN YOU ARE SWITCHING YOUR TIRES, MAKE SURE TO SWITCH OUT ALL FOUR, NOT JUST TWO! PUTTING WINTER TIRES ON THE FRONT OR BACK ONLY WILL NOT GIVE YOU PROPER HANDLING AND CONTROL.
5. PLEASE REMEMBER TO REPLACE WINTER TIRES REGULARLY! TREADS, EVEN ON WINTER TIRES, DO BECOME WORN OVER TIME.
